
Road Trauma Support Services

Aims of the service

- o To assist people affected by any form of vehicle trauma;
- o To advocate for legislative change that will lower the incidence of road trauma;
- o To promote availability of support services to trauma victims;
- o To provide education programs and initiatives which raise awareness of responsible road use.

- o Each year a great number of people lose their lives or are badly injured in accidents or road rage incidents. These tragedies cause immense emotional and physical pain for the survivors and the families of those people killed or injured.

o The sudden and tragic death of a family member or friend is traumatic and the grief of loss intense. The lives of those left behind are changed forever.

- o Dealing with the trauma and grief and integrating this tragic event into daily living requires courage and the support of other people, such as partners, family, friends and counsellors.

- o The Road Trauma Support Network recognises that those who share a common experience can best understand and support others in their grief and pain.

- o For this reason the Support Group aims to bring people together in a caring and safe environment to give and receive mutual support.

Each Support Group meeting is facilitated by a professional Counsellor.
